It may sound familiar as they are words to the wonderful hymn, "Now Thank We All Our God". When you realize what was going on in the life of Martin Rinkart when he wrote the hymn, it certainly is a hymn of gratitude amidst tremendous strife. May our hearts and minds in 2020 resound with the same gratitude for the Lord Jesus Christ.

For the month of September, donations for the church's general fund were down from prior months while expenses were higher. There was a quarterly payment during the month for the church's insurance in the amount of \$1,919.

The audio/visual technology fund paid expenses of \$6,832 during the month, which left an ending balance of \$1,648.20.

Two Coat Drives: Westside Urban **Ministry and DNA**

There will be two opportunities to provide a coat to a child in need this winter. First is the annual Westside

Urban Ministry (WUM) Drive sponsored by our Presbytery. For November, any coats dropped off at the church before by November 9 will be taken to the Covenant Presbyterian Church on Saturday November 10. More information on this ministry is below.

The Presbytery's Westside Urban Ministry (WUM) is once again providing winter jackets (and hats and mittens) to Columbus City Schools' kids. WUM collects new or gently-used winter gear from our Presbytery Churches (P.C.), the Harmony Project, and others, and then distributes about 20 coats to a school's nurse or counselor for them to give to a child when she/he comes to school with no coat, hat or mittens. Last year we were able to supply coats to 66 schools! We are often asked, "What sizes do you need?" We need mostly elementary and middle school size jackets. But we can also use lined or heavy hooded sweatshirts for the high school kids.

In early December DNA will also especially need new children's coats for Christmas. They will also be accepting good used coats for the Kids Closet program. Any coats provided after November 9 will be given to DNA. You are welcome to drop coats off on Sunday or you can stop by during office hours, Tuesday, Wednesday or Friday mornings 9 until 1. Give the office a call 614-873-5011 to let Carolyn know you are stopping by.
