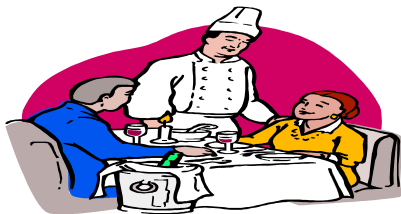


**PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN'S NEWS...**
