Dear Church Family,

It is hard to believe that we are entering into the month of September. The last several months have been tough months as we have been dealing with the pandemic, a lot of violence and unrest in our inner cities, and now as we approach a tumultuous presidential election. The Plain City Church Fellowship has been working together to address all these issues before us in a church wide sermon series entitled The Way of Jesus: Kingdom Culture in a Fractured World. This series will begin on September 13, 2020. Each pastor will prepare and preach his/her own sermon based on a common theme. There will also be short video clips provided by area clergy that will be viewed during worship (hopefully our new screen will be up and running).



### **MISSION UPDATE...WE ARE IN THIS TOGETHER!**

- We continue to give a monthly donation to the Plain City Food Pantry. DNA at this time is doing okay but needs are greatly increasing due to people losing jobs because of Covid-19. Session will reevaluate distribution of mission giving. DNA is also having increased needs for transitional housing for folks who are in need. If you know of any house that could be used for transitional housing or you have some property to be used to build transitional housing, please let Rev. Alice know.
- Delivery of eggs, bread and milk was made on August 17th to Pleasant Valley. Next delivery will be the third Monday, September 21. If you can help, let Rev Alice know.
- Finances for these mission opportunities to our community come from mission money we have in our budget plus the generous donations from the congregation. OUR FUNDS ARE RUNNING LOW. After mission money is sent this month to the Food Pantry and to Der Dutchman for the Pleasant Valley distribution, we will have around \$500 left. If you are able to give to the mission fund it would be greatly appreciated!

The Session has decided to establish the Judy Walker Music Scholarship Fund. As you know, Judy was also very involved in the Jonathan Alder Schools as a teacher as well as pianist for musicals and graduations for many years. We thought this was a great way to honor her musical gifts at both our church and at the school. This scholarship would also encourage future generations of students in music. Each year a graduating student will be chosen. The amount given each year will be determined by the funds that become available.

The Session established the scholarship by moving \$1,000.00 from the music fund to the Judy Walker Music Scholarship Fund.
