# REOPENING UPDATES! NEW SAFETY GUIDELINES!

The Session met tonight (6/2) regarding updating our safety guidelines. We are fully aware we cannot please everyone, but we hope our plan will satisfy the majority of our church family. We are all anxiously awaiting the day when covid will be behind us!

This is the decision we have made.

1. No longer will temps be taken at the door. If you are not feeling well or have been exposed to Covid, please stay home and watch online.

2. All vaccinated individuals are no longer required to wear masks.

3. We know there might be some who are uncomfortable sitting near an unmasked individual. We will have a special pew section by the parlor ONLY as an area for those who still choose to wear a mask <u>and</u> want to socially distance from others. Pews will be marked off with tape in that section only to make it easier to so-cially distance from others.

4. Sanitizing will still continue.

We are grateful for your cooperation! You have been wonderful and responsible in this very trying season! Should you have any questions, please let me know. We will continue to revisit this as things change. We will also make decisions about when outside groups can use our building in August.
